### INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SAFETY AND LIAISON

The Department of Community Safety and Liaison is committed to skills development by providing opportunities for unemployed undergraduates and graduates to gain experience in various skills. People with disabilities are encouraged to apply. The Department invites applicants to join the Internship Programme for a period of six months.

Interns will be placed within the Department of Community Safety and Liaison: KwaZulu-Natal (Pietermaritzburg). Successful candidates will be responsible for arranging their own accommodation and transport. The Department will pay a monthly stipend as outlined in the relevant prescripts.

**Requirement:** A valid, relevant National Diploma/degree or equivalent qualification.

Preference will be given to youth and people with disability. Recruitment will be done in line with the Employment Equity Plan in the following fields:

- Social Sciences specialising in one or more of the following fields: Sociology, Criminology, Social Work, Political Science, Community Development Studies, Research, Statistics, Information Management and/or related fields (Five posts)
- Commerce specialising in one of the following fields: Supply Chain Management, Internal Control, Risk Management and Accounting (Four posts)
- Human Resource Management (One post)
- Information Technology (One post)
- Communications (One post)
- Auxiliary Services (One post)

Certified copies of qualifications and identity document, as well as an application letter and curriculum vitae should accompany the Z.83 form (obtainable from government institutions). Successful candidates will be required to enter into an Internship Agreement.
